  - b) Review and discussion of correspondence from bond counsel regarding expenditure and investment of bond proceeds and Internal Revenue Service restrictions on same;
  - c) Consider approval of closing memorandum and authorize distribution of funds in accordance with same, and the taking of any actions required in connection therewith;
  - d) Consider and act upon any other matters in connection with the issuance of the Bonds, including the approval and execution of various closing documents, including authorizing release of funds to the developers, and authorization for Bond Counsel to proceed with closing on the sale of the Bonds; and the taking of any actions required in connection therewith;
- 6. Consider the approval and execution of an Amendment to the Amended and Restated District Information Form relative to the Bonds; and
- 7. Matters for placement on future agendas.
